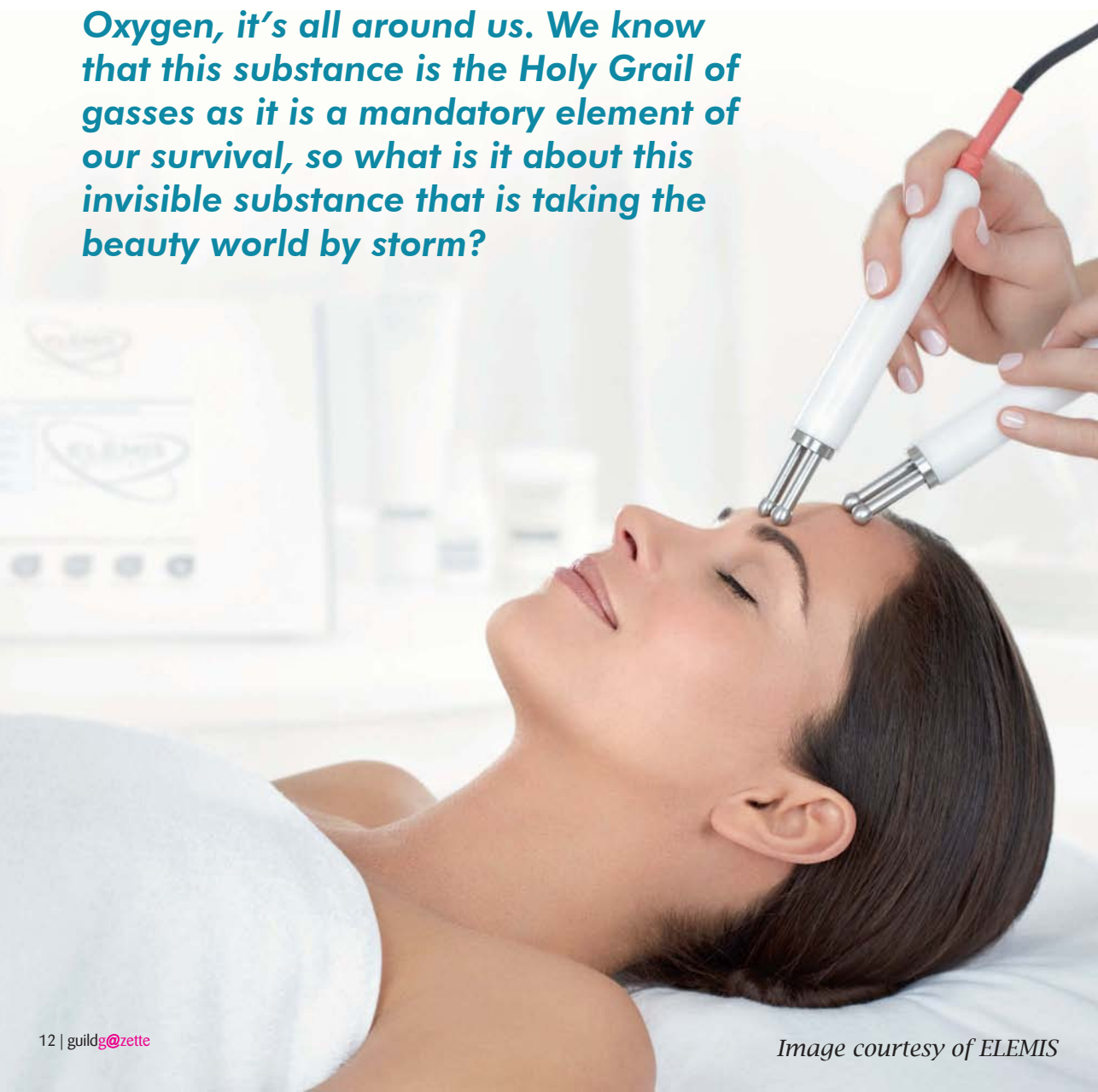


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A Breath Of Fresh Air

A majority of popular beauty and hair treatments, such as hairdressing, spray tanning and even eyelash extensions have an element of relaxation. However, holistic treatments such as Reiki, the Indian Head Massage and Ear Candling are all gaining popularity due to their internal and physical benefits. As well as being relaxing, holistic treatments offer a soul cleanse.

Ear Candling can cure conditions such as tinnitus, sinus congestion or excessive ear wax production and as ears are a pathway to the head the treatment is also known to clear the mind. You can train in Ear Candling with the GTi Ear Candling Course. There is no excuse as to why a treatment with so many benefits should not feature on your beauty business treatment menu.

What Is Ear Candling?

Ear Candling is an ancient traditional practice that was used by the Ancient Greeks, in Ancient China and by the Ancient Egyptians (Telegraph, 2018).

The treatment was popularised by the Hopi Indian Tribe of the American South West. This is why the practice is often referred to as 'Hopi Ear Candling'.

The practice is carried out by inserting the tapered end of an ear candle into a client's ear whilst the opposite end of the candle is lit. The belief is that earwax and other impurities will be drawn out from the ear, as a partial vacuum is created by the candle flame (Dictionary.com, 2018). The heat from the candle's flame helps to soften excess ear wax.



Ear Candling Continued...

What Are The Health Benefits Of Ear Candling?

The main reason for ear candling is to remove the build-up of ear wax. The treatment is safer for the ears than the traditional removal method of syringing.

Syringing the ears to remove build-up involves flushing the ears with pressurised water. The pressure can damage eardrums, and the water can introduce the risk of infection. Ear candling does not put any pressure on ear drums, nor does the practice bring any risk of infection. (Positive Health Wellness, 2016-2017).

Ear Candling can be especially beneficial to those who suffer with sinus related congestion ailments, ear wax over-production, and tinnitus. Nasal congestion can cause issues to the ears, as congestion travels through to the ears.

An excess amount of ear wax can cause problems with hearing and can be very uncomfortable,

removing the ear wax through Ear Candling means that the client's risk of recurring ear infections is reduced.



What Are The Holistic Benefits Of Ear Candling?

Ear Candling can be used to rebalance the individual's mental state. Many patients report that they can think with better clarity after the treatment. Dealing with hearing loss, ringing of the ears or any cold symptoms can often cloud our thoughts. (Positive Health Wellness, 2016-2017). The treatment itself also brings peace to patients; the whooshing sound omitted from the candle is known to be invigorating and relaxing.
